- <sup>2</sup> **Study cycle:** Short cycle (EQF level 5) / bachelor or equivalent first cycle (EQF level 6) / master or equivalent second cycle (EQF level 7) / doctorate or equivalent third cycle (EQF level 8).
- <sup>3</sup> **Erasmus+ Coordinator/Contact person**: a person who provides a link for administrative information and who, depending on the structure of the higher education institution, may be the departmental coordinator or will work at the international relations office or equivalent body within the institution.

#### <sup>10</sup> Language competence

You will normally be expected to have some proficiency in the language used for tuition in the receiving institution and you will gain most benefit from your exchange if you have some proficiency in the country's native language.

The actual level will be determined after the student's Erasmus+ nomination by the first OLS assessment.
